

## Stations, ports and airports

**Railway stations**, sea terminals and airports are places where a number of different crimes can take place. Therefore, it is very important to keep your eyes wide open.

**When arriving** or leaving late at night it is advisable to have someone accompanying you or picking you up.

**Don't address** illicit street vendors offering various services such as taxis, hotel accommodation, and tourist tours. Remember they often don't have any insurance cover.

**Always take care of** your luggage; don't bring too much and don't leave it unattended.

**If you** are worried by the people around you or you feel scared, contact the Railway or Border Police.

**Many crooks** hang about around stations, so avoid hidden corners and dark and isolated areas.

**Give and expect** clear appointments in places and with people you can easily spot.

**If your train** or your means of transport is late, don't accept any off-the-cut substitute travel organized by strangers or non-authorized people.
